### CURRENT & RECENT GRADS

The WRP is a government-wide program co-sponsored by the U.S. Department of Labor and the U.S. Department of Defense. The goal of the program is to increase Federal employment opportunities for college students and recent graduates with disabilities through internships or permanent jobs.

Current college/university undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral students and recent graduates who are eligible for the Schedule A hiring authority can apply through WRP-participating schools or on [wrp.gov](http://wrp.gov). ### ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the WRP, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be 18 years old or older
- Have a Schedule A qualified disability
- Be a current college or university undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student, or a recent graduate of a U.S. accredited college or university
