



WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT PROGRAM (WRP) AT DOW

CURRENT & RECENT GRADS

The WRP is a government-wide program managed by the U.S. Department of Labor and largely used by the Department of War (DOW). The program aims to increase federal employment opportunities for Schedule A eligible college students and recent graduates through internships.

SIGN UP!

Current college/university undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral students and recent graduates who are eligible for the Schedule A hiring authority can apply through WRP-participating schools or on wrp.gov. Visit wrp.gov or contact your school's disability services or career services coordinator to determine if your school is a current WRP participant.

ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the WRP, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be at least 16 years old
- Have a Schedule A qualified disability
- Be a current college or university undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student, or a recent graduate of a U.S. accredited college or university

- Make connections with potential employers
- Learn about federal government and private-sector employment opportunities
- Get support from a network of professionals with disabilities
- Increase your chances of being hired after graduation
